1. All dogs must be up to date on vaccines and have been seen by a veterinarian within the last year. As well all dogs above 6 months of age are required to have been spayed or neutered to be in day care. It is recommended that you vaccinate your dog against Kennel Cough as being around other dogs increases your dogs risk of getting Kennel Cough.
2. No dogs are allowed to attend day care if they are showing signs of illness. Should your dog become ill throughout the day we will call you and request you to pick up your dog.
3. No dogs will be admitted to day care if they have not been seen by the attending trainers and are demonstrating aggression.
4. No dogs with a history of biting another being whether it be human or animals will be admitted to day care until the behavior has been modified.
5. Payment for day care is due on the day the bookings are made. No refunds will be given if you do not attend unless it is a result of a medical emergency, or your canine is ill and a veterinarian has advised not to be around other dogs. In these situations, proof of such is required and a credit will be allotted to be used within the 30 days. If a day is booked without payment, and the dog results in a no show, payment for the spot is required and prepayment is needed for future days.
6. Should you require an earlier drop off time than 7:30 am, this can be pre arranged at independent with the trainer who is opening that day.
7. Pick up times: A later pick up than 5:30 pm will result in an additional fee of \$5.00 per 10 minutes or portion of.
8. If you are going to be late for pick up, please call and notify us as soon as possible.
9. No dog can be received into daycare with out a proper fitting collar (break away) and leash.
10. We have volunteers that are willing to take dogs for a walk. If you would like your dog to be walked by a volunteer, a permission form is required. However if your dog does not walk well on a leash, they may not be taken on the walk. You can provide us with an alternative to assist them on walking nice such as a head halter or a prong collar; we will not walk an untrained dog on a choker as it is dangerous and can possibly choke the dog.
11. In case of an emergency, we will require a number where you can be reached as well as your veterinarian's number. Canada's Canine Academy and staff are not liable for injury sustained at the facility or on property unless it occurred during negligence by staff.
